Training to be a Spiritual Director

Spiritual direction helps Christians pursue a closer relationship with God. In the midst of a chaotic life it can be hard to carve out time to invest in our own spiritual growth. As our contemplation deepens, we begin to more easily identify His presence in even the smallest moments or the most mundane experiences of life.
